- Provide explanations on spectacle prescriptions as prescribed by the optometrist
- Monitor and maintain inventory and liaise with suppliers to ensure stock is available and meets sales trends
- Complete arrivals of all frames and lens orders
- Ordering and coordinating contact lens orders
- Pre-testing patients including OCT, ultra-wide camera and Visual fields when required

General Administrative and Clerical Duties

All staff will be cross-trained in practice areas of reception and customer service. Duties will include:

- Making and scheduling appointments using the practice management software system
- Reception and administrative duties (e.g., scanning, emailing)
- Answering phone enquiries
- Managing patient appointments
- Monitoring of the waiting room, light cleaning, disinfecting, and tidying duties
- Providing assistance and support to the optometrist and vision therapy staff members
